# LETTER FROM THE *executive director*

---

As I look back at 2014, I am reminded of the resiliency of this organization during a year of changes and challenges. There was a change in leadership; the acquisition of a new building; our capital campaign was re-energized; there were staff changes, board member changes; and the list goes on. In the midst of it all, WCFR flourished. We served more meals than previous years, added Nutrition Essentials to our program menu, and formed new partnerships for Nutrition-to-Go. We welcomed new donors, volunteers and finalized plans for renovating our new home. At the heart of it all is a mission that resonates across our community. When we focus on our mission, we do our best work and make the greatest impact.

As I look ahead, I see an abundance of opportunities and possibilities to improve our services and reach more families. We've quadrupled our capacity for meal preparation and doubled the size of our dining room. The new facility positions us to provide more meals to more individuals, both in-house and in collaboration with other community agencies. We're also planning a classroom and demonstration kitchen that will allow us to connect women and children with healthy food options, promote self-sufficiency and teach food safety. We'll introduce programming to promote budgeting, planning and saving.

After relocating to our new home, we identified new opportunities to enhance Nutrition Essentials, our food and health education program. We're developing partnerships to support children's literacy and promote their healthy eating behaviors through "Hungry to Read." This effort will include a reading corner and utilize the power of stories to spark healthy eating and physical activity behaviors in the kids who come to the restaurant for dinner. They will be able to enjoy a good book or listen to a story in their own little corner of the restaurant.

Thank you for being such a valued member of the WCFR family. We are honored by your trust, and strive to be good stewards of your investment in the quality of life of the women and children we serve. It is difficult to place a value on the impact of your giving – healthy families; happy, nourished children; a feeling of safety – these are priceless outcomes that change lives in immeasurable ways. We cannot thank you enough!

---

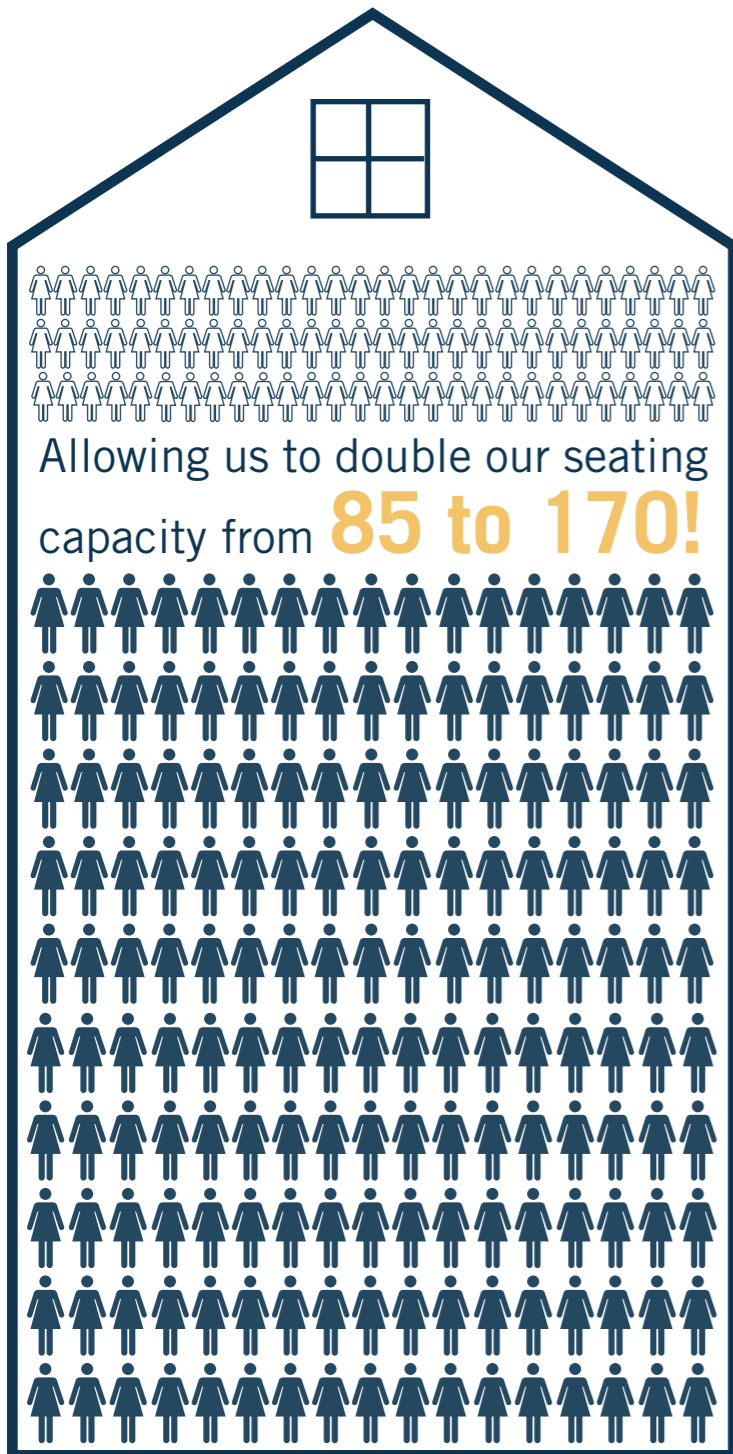

This means many of these women, children and families cannot afford to feed themselves, despite trying to budget their limited resources to last until the end of the month. Fortunately, WCFR believes that everyone should be treated to a nutritious meal, served by caring volunteers in a welcoming setting with dignity and respect.

We would not be the thriving and welcoming place that we are without all of the wonderful people who help us on a daily basis! Our volunteers do everything from prepping food for meals and washing dishes, to laundry and handyman projects. **12,388 hours** of their valuable time was utilized in 2014 - this equates to 6 full time employees.

## We launched Nutrition Essentials!

A program to help educate families on improving their physical and financial health through nutrition education, cooking skills, and stretching limited food dollars. Nutrition Essentials is designed to equip women and children with knowledge and resources designed to improve their overall health and reduce the risk of preventable diseases such as obesity and type 2 diabetes. Support includes cooking workshops and goal setting for women's health, and the health of their families.

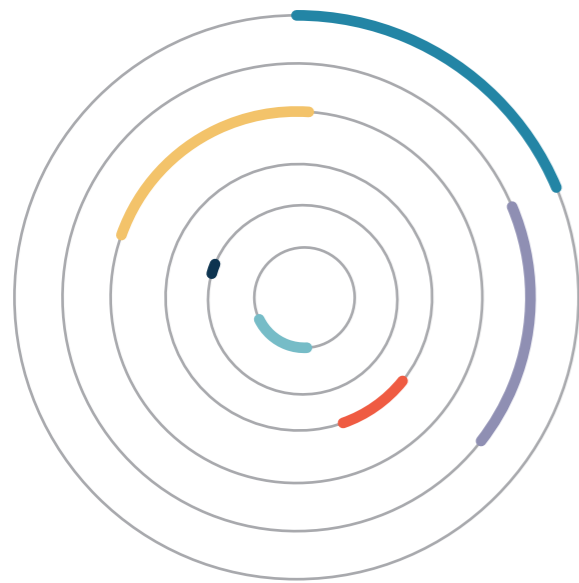

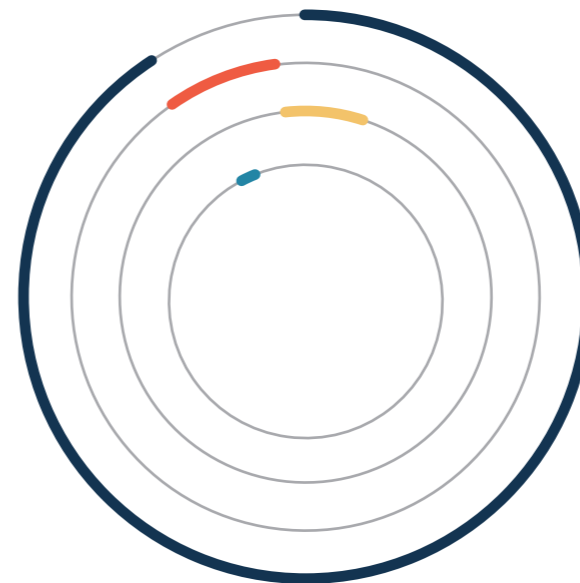

CONTRIBUTIONS - \$829,531



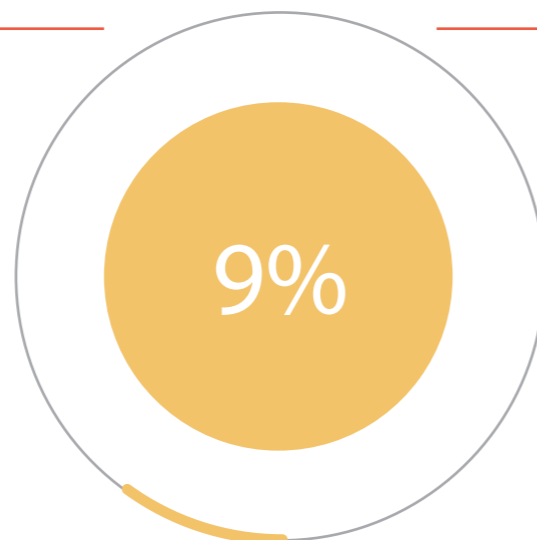

### **Expand our Catering Services**

We take pride in the fact that the meals we serve are healthy and scratch-made from quality ingredients. WCFR intends to develop its catering business and use this income stream to grow and enhance our programs. From board meetings to family events, we have the talent and creativity to make any event deliciously memorable.

### **Launch “Serve it Up” – A collaboration of corporate compassion.**

There is a change occurring in how corporations give back. They don't just want to sign checks anymore. They want to collaborate and build a culture of community giving. They want to see where their money is going and get more hands-on with the community organizations they support. Corporate volunteers help create healthier communities and enrich their own lives by giving back. WCFR will offer new sponsorship opportunities that combine financial support with volunteer opportunities.

### **Demonstration Kitchen & Classroom**

We will continue to raise funding to renovate two rooms in our building for larger Nutrition Essentials classes; cooking and food safety demonstrations; and programming to assist our clients with budgeting and smart food choices.

### **Increase Number of Meals Served**

We have the capacity to seat over 250 people for every meal service in the restaurant and include additional community partners in our Nutrition-to-Go Program.
